

# SHAC MEETING MINUTES from 9/30/13<sup>5</sup>

The meeting began with election of a secretary, Amy Harrington volunteered for the position.

Nurse Leslie discussed becoming compliant with immunizations on both campuses with immunization records being up to date by December 2, 2015.

Next was the cafeteria update with Nicole Bingham introducing Sybil and Rhonda as new staff members. Nicole also shared that the a la carte station was up and running and that the Elementary kids were only allowed to purchase on Friday. She then shared about the new menu and how some of those new items were a big hit.

The next item discussed by Nurse Leslie was that the SHAC Committee was in charge of writing a new wellness policy and that it will need to be presented to the School Board.

Nurse Leslie then shared about the Big Decisions /Sex Education Program and who would be presenting it. It's a two week program for 8<sup>th</sup> graders consisting of 8- one hour sessions. Also, there will be a 30 minute session update for 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grades. There is a possibility to have a session for 7<sup>th</sup> graders as well. It was discussed as to importance of that age/grade level for this topic to be addressed as it had been many years since the students at NCCISD had done this program. It was also discussed that parents had the choice to for their student to "opt out."

Next, Nurse Leslie shared that Red Ribbon Week, the anti-drug, drinking, and bullying campaign was to be the same as Homecoming Spirit week. Kids would be rewarded for their consistent participation.

Next, Nurse Leslie shared a new idea of Student Post Cards as a way of tracking kid's growth from beginning of the school year to the end of term. Post card would have pictures and list achievements, progression, and growth throughout the year and will be given as a Parent gift at the end of the school year.

Lastly, Nurse Leslie discussed that she would send out invitations to the next meeting.
