

# SHAC MEETING MINUTES 11/24/2015

Meeting was held in Teacher's Lounge of Nueces Canyon Elementary School on Tuesday, November 24, 2015.

Meeting opened with everyone signing in. In attendance were: Leslie Calliet, Nicole Bingham, Luci Harmon, Amy Harrington, Nurse Fredlyn Wideman, and Kristi Powers. Minutes from the meeting on 9/30/2015 were read, discussed and approved by Nicole Bingham and second by Luci Harmon.

Nurse Fredlyn Wideman, presented an outline of the Big Decisions Curriculum (a sex education curriculum). It was decided to just present this curriculum to the 8<sup>th</sup> graders as it's easier to schedule with their Health class and the students are more mature and the curriculum is more age appropriate for that grade. It was also discussed the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grades will have a mini, follow-up session. It was also decided there will be a parent session to be held before the curriculum is presented to students. There will be an "opt" out option for students which must be consented by parent. Also, students may not participate in the Big Decisions Curriculum without parental consent. Members of the SHAC committee will present this information and curriculum outline to the NCCISD School Board at the January 18, 2016 for approval. The vote to approach the school board for permission was held by Kristi Powers with all in favor, and motion carried, and a second by Nicole Bingham.

The tentative dates for the Big Decisions Curriculum to begin will be April 18 and April 25, 2016. Classes will be held in the Home Economics Room, Mrs. Stotts classroom, on the Barksdale campus, during the 3<sup>rd</sup> period class time.

Next, the Wellness plan was discussed at length. Nicole Bingham, the head of cafeteria, informed the board of an impending audit. The wellness plan in place needed more "elaboration." The nurse, Physical Education and Cafeteria policies need to continue to be stated and/ or posted in the classroom, cafeteria or syllabus and will continue being implemented alongside the Student Code of Conduct for NCCISD. More discussion about the wellness plan and impending audits will continue to be topic of future SHAC meetings until final wellness plan is completed and approved.

Nicole Bingham made a motion to adjourn and it was second by Luci Harmon.
