United States Government and Economics

This class is divided into two subjects: the first semester United States Government and the second semester Economics.

The focus of the U.S. Government course is on the structure and function of our government as well as the principles and beliefs on which it was founded. A significant portion of the course focuses on the U.S. Constitution.

The second semester students will study Economics which can be called the science of scarcity - how to supply seemingly unlimited wants with a limited supply. The students will learn the three basic questions all societies must answer: What to produce? How to produce? For whom to produce?
