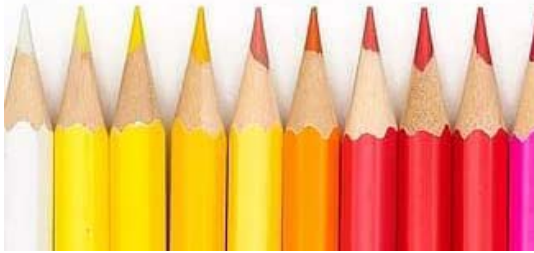
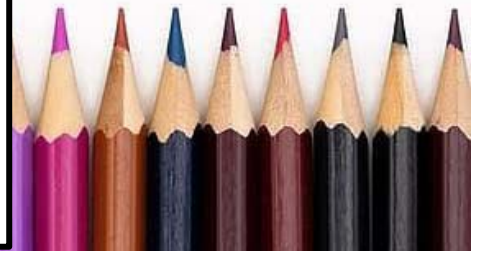

COURSE FOCUS
