In Reading and Writing, students will engage in activities that build on their prior knowledge and skills in order to strengthen their reading, writing, listening, and oral language skills. Students will continue to apply previously learned knowledge with greater depth in increasingly more complex texts as they become self-directed, critical leaders.

In Math, students are adding and subtracting whole numbers, organizing and analyzing data and building number sense through number relationships. We will also be working with two- and three- dimensional geometric figures.

In Science, students will observe and describe the natural world using their five senses. Science is done in order for students to develop and enrich their abilities to understand the world around them in the context of scientific concepts and processes.

In Social Studies, students will study their relationship to the classroom, school, and community in order to establish the foundation for responsible citizenship in society.

Grading Policy:

Test- 40%

Classroom Work- 60%

There will NOT be any extra credit. Students may re-do any failing daily grade, and it will be averaged with the previous failing grade. That grade will then be entered into the gradebook.

Students must make up any missed work and/or tests. The student will have three days to get any make up work turned in. Should the student not meet the required three day deadline, a zero will then be entered into the gradebook for each missing assignment.
