Grading Policy:

Quiz: A quiz will be any type of work performed in the classroom setting. Examples of this would be any typed Worksheets, Record books, drawings and basically all paper work done in classroom. This will count for 15% of their grade. They will receive the grade they earn with no makeup or extra-credit.

Test: 2 Part Systems. This will involve both Lab and written exams including the welding certifications test. This will count for **60%** of their grade.

Skill Test: Done in lab Hands On. Mastering the skill they are working on. Examples are welding test pass or plumbing and electrical project. All Students will have the opportunity to retake these tests but can only receive an 80 on any retakes.

Written: This involves all written tests given throughout the year. Each student will be given the opportunity to take the test three times in order to pass the highest grade that can be given on the first written test retake is 80 and on second retake a 70 is the highest grade given.

Daily Work: This is the process of learning a skill such as welding. Much of our time is spent in the shop performing a skill. This is a developmental process so the grade will be given based on their willingness to learn the skill, attitude, safe conduct and work ethic. How they care for the tools and equipment. This grade will be affected by showing up on time just as it would in the real world. This will count for **25%** of their grade.

Weekly Work: These are tasks that have to be performed weekly for the general safety of the shop. Picking up tools and sweeping their work area to maintain a clean working environment. The student will receive a weekly grade on how they did. This will be worth **15%** of their grade.

Rules of the Shop:

1. **Take care of Business:** A good rule to live by. Take care of your responsibilities and do what is asked of you and you can't go wrong.
2. **Respect:** Respect everyone and all the equipment at all times

3. **No Horseplay:** The shop is a place for work that can be dangerous if not treated with respect. Horseplay will not be tolerated and shop privileges could be lost.
4. **Wear Safety Equipment:** You must have on eye protection at all times in the shop no matter the project. You also need to wear the appropriate safety gear for the task that is being performed.
5. **No Foul Language:** The occasional slip will happen but the words should not be used in day to day conversation.
6. **Cheating:** Cheating will not be tolerated and the student will receive a **ZERO** on that assignment.
